Telehealth will be used to deliver the program to those residing in rural areas.

Providence Regional Cancer Center	6 Komen Eastern Washington Affiliate Counties	<i>Interviews of Women Utilizing Screening &amp; Diagnostic Services:</i> To interview approximately 50 women from 6 NE Washington counties, use interview data in combination with epidemiologic and community survey data to create strategies and systems that will improve healthcare access and delivery.
Spokane Tribe of Indians	Spokane, Stevens, Lincoln, Pend Oreille Counties	<i>Spokane Tribal Breast Health Program:</i> To identify through educational activities and primary healthcare interventions, women in need of routine screening mammography and breast cancer education and awareness, and to provide the needed services to those women.
Because There is Hope	Spokane and surrounding Eastern Washington Affiliate Counties	<i>Patient Transportation Expenses:</i> To provide gas cards to patients who must travel over 50 miles to Spokane for breast cancer treatment.
N.A.T.I.V.E. Project	Spokane, Stevens, Pend Oreille Counties	<i>Native Women's Health Initiative:</i> To provide culturally competent breast health education and access to screening mammograms, targeting American Native and Alaska Native women. Outreach to ensure the Native community is aware of the need for continued screening will also be done.
Colville Confederated Tribes	Okanagan, Ferry	<i>Breast Cancer Empowering Assistance &amp; Resources (BEAR) Project:</i> To provide awareness and education to people of the Colville Confederated Tribes, promote access to breast health screening and treatment, and to provide emotional support to breast cancer survivors.
Kennewick General Hospital	Benton, Franklin	<i>A Breast Health Education Project:</i> To establish a Spanish-Language <i>Buddy Check 25</i> program to provide tools and education to the Hispanic community. The program will provide at least 500 enrollees with free tools, culturally sensitive information and education, encouraging self-breast awareness and mammography.
Lourdes Health Network	Benton & Franklin	<i>Breast Cancer Outreach &amp; Education Project:</i> To offer education about breast health, prevention and screening procedures as well as free mammograms to un- or underinsured women over the age of 40 and under the age of 64.
Walla Walla Community Hospice	Walla Walla & Columbia Counties	<i>Medications for Pain Management &amp; Symptom Control &amp; Durable Medical Equipment Supplies for Hospice Patients with Breast Cancer:</i> To purchase medications for pain control and symptom management, and for rental of durable medical equipment for comfort care for up to 14 hospice patients with breast cancer.
Community Health Education & Resources (CHER)	Spokane	<i>Nutrition &amp; Breast Cancer Risk Education:</i> To educate the community about the link between nutrition and breast cancer by distributing 2000 educational postcards, hosting a webpage, and delivering community presentations and one on one nutrition consults.
Community Health Association Spokane (CHAS)	Spokane	<i>CHAS Breast Health Awareness Campaign:</i> To reduce barriers to care by providing breast health education and clinical breast exams to 523 low income, uninsured women.
Garfield County Health District	Garfield	<i>Community Education, Awareness, &amp; Accessing Services:</i> To provide education and services to under and uninsured women through various innovative activities throughout the year, including a community walk, in-person distribution of calendars, and displaying a 'pink ribbon' Christmas tree at a local bank.
Othello Community Hospital	Adams	<i>Othello Area Mammography Screening Awareness Project:</i> To provide awareness, education, and breast health screening, including 100 digital mammograms, for under- or uninsured individuals.
Providence Center for Faith & Healing	Spokane	<i>Creative Therapies in Breast Cancer Support Groups:</i> To use art therapy in conjunction with breast cancer support groups to improve quality of life for breast cancer patients and their families. One art therapy support group will consist of breast cancer patients only whereas another group will be composed of breast cancer patients who participate with their children.
Spokane County Medical Society Foundation	Spokane	<i>Project Access:</i> To provide breast care and treatment coordination for up to 8 patients with breast disease who are uninsured and reside in Spokane County.
Whitman County Health Department	Whitman	<i>Whitman County Breast Health Program:</i> To raise awareness of breast cancer screening by distributing promotional and educational materials throughout the county, and to provide up to 10 breast health exams and screening mammograms to uninsured persons.
Women's Recovery Program at Anna Ogden Hall	Spokane	<i>Healthy Breasts Program:</i> To provide one-on-one education and screening and connect vulnerable women in need of follow-up services with the Breast Cervical and Colon Health Program (BCCHP).
